<u>Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Capital Region</u>, a non-profit mentoring program for children facing adversity, will host <u>Bowl for Kids' Sake</u>. This event is part of a larger <u>national</u> event that will help raise awareness of Big and Little matches that have yet to be made.

These everyday heroes make a significant impact on the lives of countless kids and young adults in the Capital District. We'll be highlighting a brother and sister from Albany who are thriving thanks in part to their Big Brother and Big Sister. Romaillow is a 12-year-old boy in 6th grade and he and his Big Brother Patrick were matched more than a year ago. Romaillow enjoys sports, Legos, arts and crafts, and science. His little sister "Nana" is 8 years old, a 3th grader and she was matched with her Big Sister, Emily, more than six months ago. Nana is a movie girl, loves being outside, dancing and playing soccer. Nana and Romaillow are both outgoing and talkative.

The event will take place on **March 10th at Spare Time** in Clifton Park. Participants are encouraged to *dress as their favorite super hero* to raise money for a good cause, and enjoy two games, some pizza, beverages, and a souvenir bowling shirt, all for just \$25 per person, including shoe rental. There is a limit of four people per team. Teams can select from three 2-hour time slots to play their games.
