Like her fellow staff members, Jackie helps out with other aspects of agency operations, too. She conducts a few volunteer orientations a year and represents Big Brothers Big Sisters at community events to recruit new Littles and Bigs.

Outside of Big Brothers Big Sisters, Jackie works as a science journalist and editor. Her favorite things to write about are the brain, health, and medicine. When she's not working, she likes to play sports, dance, and read. She also likes to play with her cat, Sox--named for both his white paws and the Boston Red Sox.
