ABOUT BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS

Established nationally in 1904, and in 1964 in the Capital Region, Big Brothers Big Sisters is the oldest youth mentoring organization in the United States. We provide children (we call them "Littles"), ages 6-18, with mentors (we call them "Bigs") in professionally supported one-to-one relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth. In partnership with six local colleges and universities, school districts, businesses, and the community-at-large, we create relationships that change lives for the better, forever.

OUR PURPOSE: To clear the path to a child's biggest future.

Over the long-term, our goal for our Littles is that they graduate by the time they are 18 years old with a path for the future and a mentor for a lifetime. Our programs are data-proven to create long-term social mobility, close opportunity gaps, and break the cycle of generational poverty.





Mentoring Support Partnership (Underwrites Core Programs)

\$100,000 Defend Potential Community-Based Mentoring

This two-year partnership underwrites BBBSCR's core program. Community-Based mentoring relationships involve one-on-one outings and activities, doing things the Big and Little enjoy together, like taking a walk in the park, going to a museum, playing ball, exploring a new activity, or just hanging out and talking.

\$40,000 Empower Possibility Site-Based Mentoring

This annual partnership underwrites BBBSCR's site-based programs. BBBSCR partners with local businesses and colleges (currently at University at Albany, The College of St. Rose, Union College, Siena College, Skidmore College, and Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute) to offer one-to-one site-based mentoring relationships.

\$25,000 Ignite Opportunity One-to-One Mentoring Program

This annual partnership underwrites BBBSCR's Big Experience monthly program. Open the door to possibility for children from underserved families through our Big Experience monthly program serving current Littles and the children on our waiting list.

\$12,000 Platinum Level Mentoring Support

This annual partnership underwrites BBBSCR's general mentoring plus the U-CAN mentoring program serving Albany and Schenectady County adolescents in the juvenile justice system.

\$6,000 Gold Level Mentoring Support

This annual partnership underwrites BBBSCR's general mentoring plus the Fostering Futures mentoring program. Community volunteers serve as "extended families" for foster parents and children.

\$2,500 Silver Level Mentoring Support

This annual partnership underwrites several professionally-supported BBBSCR Big/Little matches for one year.

This annual partnership underwrites one professionally-supported BBBSCR Big/Little match for one year.


