Established in 1964, Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Capital Region provides children (we call them "Littles"), ages 6-18, with mentors (we call them "Bigs") in professionally supported one-to-one relationships that ignite the power and promise of youth. In partnership with six local colleges and universities, school districts, businesses, and the community-at-large, we create relationships that change lives for the better, forever.

OUR PURPOSE: To clear the path to a child's biggest future.

Over the long-term, our goal for our Littles is that they graduate by the time they are 18 years old with a path for the future and a mentor for a lifetime. Our programs are data-proven to create long-term social mobility, close opportunity gaps, and break the cycle of generational poverty.
